Subject: Recommended Edits to the District of Lantzville Parks, Trails and Recreation Plan, 2008; and the Trails and Journeyways Strategy, 2010

Background:

District of Lantzville Council, pursuant to its March 20, 2024 resolution, directed the Parks and Trails Select Committee to:

“review the 2010 Lantzville Trails and Journeyways Strategy and the 2008 Parks and Trails Plan, and provide recommended edits to Council”.

Approach:

The Committee, commencing in June 2024, read these documents and took into account the District of Lantzville’s Official Community Plan (OCP), its applicable objectives and policies, and the Community Vision Statement. The Committee noted the community’s desire to retain a semi-rural atmosphere, make connections from the Foothills to the Salish Sea, and provide a future with *an abundance of trees, green spaces, and corridors, walking/hiking/bicycling paths and trails...* (Reference: OCP 2019 Section 4.1 Community Vision).

The Committee also conducted site visits to every pathway and dedicated park land in the District. Upon completion of these site visits, and review of the parks and pathways listed in the above-noted documents, the Committee is submitting Part 1 of its Recommended Edits to Council as follows.

Recommended Edits - Part 1:

1. **Table 1: Pathways**

Table 1 is the Committee’s Recommended Edits to *Table 3* of the *Trails and Journeyways Strategy, 2010*.

2. **Table 2: Park Land**

Table 2 is the Committee’s Recommended Edits to *Tables 3-1 and 3-2* in the *Parks, Trails and Recreation Plan, 2008, Lantzville’s Parks - current use and future improvements, pages 8-9*.

3. **Map A, 2025**

Map A 2025 is the Committee’s Recommended Edits to Map A, 2010 in the *Trails and Journeyways Strategy, 2010* document.

The Committee also considered the Active Transportation Strategy referred to by the Federal and Provincial Governments. The Recommended Edits reflect this strategy.

Conclusion:

It is the Committee's recommendation to Council that this information be used in conjunction with a number of the District's works and future works including:

1. Assisting the Active Transportation consultants in the preparation of the Active Transportation Plan;
2. Assisting Council in providing direction for future projects and OCP updates; and
3. Assisting staff by providing information on the network of pathways and park land in Lantzville.

The Parks and Trails Select Committee thanks the Lantzville Council for the opportunity to provide Part 1 of its Recommended Edits.
