

Terminology used in Tables 1 and 2.

ID numbers:

ID numbers are identifiers only and are not intended to assign priority. They are used for ease of reference to the pathways and park land listed in Tables 1 and 2.

ID numbers are also on Map A, 2025 to show the locations of pathways and park land.

The ID numbers are shown in the far left column of both tables with Project #'s from the 2010 document shown below in brackets.

Project #'s:

These were used in *Table 3 of the 2010 Trails and Journeyways Strategy* for most, but not all, pathways shown on Map A of that document.

NN (Not Numbered):

The letters NN (Not Numbered) are found in the left column of Table 1, when a pathway was shown on Map A, 2010, but was not assigned a project number.

NN is also found in the left column of Table 2 for park land shown with a star on the 2010 document and on OCP Map 5, 2019. The stars were not numbered in these documents.

RE (Recommended Edit):

Some pathways and park land are newer than 2010 (ex. Pierce Woods Marine Park) and therefore were not shown in the 2010 or 2008 documents. These are identified in the left column of the tables with the letter "RE".

PP (Proposed Park Land):

Two listings in Table 2 show the letters PP (proposed park land) in the left-hand column in Table 2. PP indicates that the proposed park land was in neither the 2010 document nor OCP Map 5, 2019.

Note: ID numbers were not assigned in the first section of Table 2, "Parkland within the District of Lantzville". These park lands are identified by name, as used in the Parks, Trails and Recreation Plan, 2008. They are listed in alphabetical order.
