Report:

Now that the Design Committee has been established it can help move ahead the motions already approved by Council.

Jacks - Feb 21/24

THAT staff be directed to use the design sketch titled “Jacks Road End” for the Jacks Road beach road end improvement, as presented at the February 21, 2024 Council Meeting, as a rudimentary starting point for future input by residents and Council, in the process of achieving a final design; AND FURTHER THAT staff be directed to begin the process of removing the patches of remaining asphalt and implementing the improvements as soon as possible.

Lavender – Sept 13/23 (Note: Figure 1 in this motion is the Koers Lavender Plan dated April 2020).

THAT Council requests a report from staff outlining the works and costs to complete the following improvements [as shown in Figure 1 submitted by Mayor Swain at the COTW Sept. 6th, 2023] at the Lavender Road beach end including:

- Install parking in Area A including removal of blackberries, install a culvert and install grass matting as the parking surface
- In Area B, remove the stairs and wooden cribbing, add fill and soil, and slope the property to connect the upper and lower levels;
- In Area C, create the hammerhead vehicle turn-around including installing removable bollards, and remove all asphalt on the waterfront side of the removable bollards and replace with surface materials as per green shores best practices; AND FURTHER THAT any required land surveying or other professional services required to prepare the report for Council consideration be funded from the Accumulated General Operating Surplus Reserve Fund.

Plaza - Nov 20/24

THAT Council approve implementation of the following:

- i) “Legion Plaza Perimeter Plan” as submitted by Councillor Savage at the October 23, 2024, Council meeting as amended by removing the garbage container, removing and replacing the log sign to be replaced with 2 plaques worded by the Legion, and removing and replacing the Canoe with planters; and,
- ii) that the District of Lantzville will pay the appropriate \$980.00 cost regarding transportation and sand blasting of the Legion #257 anchor plus installation costs that may be associated, to be funded from the Community Works Fund (Gas Tax) with the 2024-2029 Financial Plan to be amended accordingly.
